Every page and piece of paper has been photographed. The National Institute was the initial repository for collections of artifacts brought to the U.S. by the United States Exploring Expedition of 1838, as well as various other objects accumulated by the government, such as items owned by early American politicians, patent models, and natural objects. There is an entry on page 25 that records the transfer of a desk used by George Washington to the Institute, as Directed by the President of the United States, with a signature of Z. Taylor.
The signature has not been authenticated, but it does appear to be in a hand other than the recording secretary. Such artifacts were the precursor to the Smithsonian Institution collection.
